<b>Use Case Name</b>	Library Walk-In Access to On-Line Databases
<b>Work Package</b>	
<b>Stakeholders &amp; Interests</b>	<p><b>Walk-in:</b> A member of the general public who wishes to access external on-line databases, from within a library.</p> <p><b>Library:</b> A library offering access to members of the general public.</p> <p><b>Database Provider:</b> An organisation that provides on-line database services to university libraries.</p>
<b>Preconditions</b>	<p>The library is licensed to provide public access to the online database from within the library.</p> <p>The library provides terminals for walk-in access.</p>
<b>Success Guarantee (Post-conditions)</b>	<p>The general public can access on-line information services.</p>
<b>Main Success Scenario (Basic Flow)</b>	<p>A walk-in user selects an online database from the public-access terminal.</p> <p>The Database Provider's SP connects to the Library's IdP.</p> <p>The Library's IdP validates the IP address range then releases the relevant attributes to the SP.</p> <p>The walk-in has access to the online database.</p>
<b>Extensions (Alternate Flow)</b>	<p>Required attributes:</p>
<b>Data Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Organisation Name (eduPersonOrgDN).</li></ul>
<b>Special Requirements</b>	<p>The <code>mod_auth_location</code> Apache module is installed on the Library's IdP.</p>
<b>Frequency of Occurrence</b>	Daily.
